Renewing the Mind

On my latest trip to Cuba in January, I was privileged to gather with a group of 25 pastors for a course entitled “Old Testament Survey II.” During our time together, I led the class through a study of poetry, wisdom literature and prophecy as we considered the truths revealed in the Book of Job through the Book of Malachi.

In addition to discussing the author, date, and historical background that shape the material, we spent a significant portion of our time talking about the implications of these ancient texts for the church today, realizing there is “nothing new under the sun.”

As I challenged the class to interact with the Scriptures, develop preaching outlines from particular passages, and prepare for their research assignment, many of the pastors seemed reluctant. It wasn’t the amount of work they were shying away from. Nor was it from an inability to think critically about God’s Word. Their hesitancy was the result of being raised in the Cuban communist regime.

As our in-country coordinator Jatniel later informed me, the system under which they had suffered did more than just impact their economic situation. It conditioned its citizenry not to think for themselves or challenge the status quo. In Cuba, the government is sovereign over all things – and its “truth” is never to be questioned.

As the students write their own papers, expressing their own point of view, pray that they would continue to be transformed by the renewing of their minds – that God would show Himself Sovereign and Christ would have His preeminence in their lives and in the church.
