Kingdom Work in East Africa

I recently returned from training trips to Yirgacheffe, Ethiopia and Entebbe, Uganda, where I had the incredible opportunity to preach in local churches and teach courses in the New Testament and Systematic Theology. At one of our newest training centers, over 30 pastors gathered in Ethiopia to take the second course with Carey International University of Theology. Not only was our in-country coordinator, Asfaw, a gracious host, the students were extremely focused and engaged as we walked through all 27 books of New Testament Scripture. Despite the language/translation barrier, we enjoyed a great time of fellowship and the class performed very well on their final exams.



In Uganda, our group of 40+ pastors took another step forward in their theological training by examining the Doctrines of Anthropology, Christology, Atonement and Salvation. It was amazing to see the growth in so many of our students, who have come so far in their ability to consider biblical truth. Our class discussions on the subjects of justification and sanctification were particularly profitable as we connected these doctrinal teachings with practical issues they were dealing with in their own ministerial context. What a blessing to see the head, heart, hands and feet all being transformed by a deepened understanding of the Gospel of Christ.



In addition to the weeks of training, I had the added privilege of presiding over the graduation of 16 pastor-students at our center in Entebbe. On Saturday, October 5th the community gathered at Cornerstone New City Church to celebrate all that God has done in the lives of these men, 6 of whom were receiving diploma awards for having successfully completed 20 courses with Carey International. In the year ahead, a few of them will even have the opportunity to earn a Bachelor's Degree in Theological Studies as part of a new pilot program being offered in-country! We praise God for the way He continues to raise up these leaders to proclaim the truth in East Africa and pray He will use these recent graduates in ways that transform their churches and communities for the glory of His Name.
